1882	Birth, Kingston, Jamaica
1897-1889	Travels with Neil McLeod on Jamaica preaching circuit.
Oct. 8, 1902	Mrs. Neil McLeod leaves Jamaica by ship for Boston, a widow. Preaches at the Methodist Church in Jamaica Mother dies and he resigns from the Methodist Church Leaves by ship to America. Faith in great doubt. Marries
1912	Twins born: Ethel A. Hall and Arthur?, Portsmouth, RI
Nov. 7, 1913	Appendicitis, Waterloo, IA (same Vincent Hall?)
June 1917	Enlists in Army at Dallas, TX, Mechanic Co. F, 12th Eng., Motorized Div., W.W. 1
Aug. 12, 1917	Arrives on troop ship to Liverpool, England from N.Y.
Aug. 21-Nov. 19, 1917	Somme Sector, France
Nov. 20-Dec. 5, 1917	Cambrai Offensive and Defensive Gassed, leg injuries , Chaplain, Lieutenant.
May 16, 1919	Mustered out of service, Camp Funston, KS Baptized by Baptist Minister
Sept. 28, 1922	Preaches at Leper Colony & Methodist Church in Singapore
Oct. 28, 1922	Carter Expedition Egypt , Tut's Tomb, "Dig Cook"
1923	"I walked the street of Thebes (Egypt) in 1923" Aug. 18, 1931 <i>Gleaner</i>
Mar. 24, 1923	Resident Minister Methodist Church, Western Australia
June 28, 1923	Egypt Allenby charges C.V. Hall to address British troops in Alexandria &
July 13, 1923	Palestine
Sept. 15, 1923	England
Sept. 25, 1923	Sails into NYC on Leviathan steamship from Southhampton, England 2 week trip
Oct. 23-Jan. 24, 1924	NYC Lecture tour : "Australia, Egypt, Palestine & Unknown God"
Oct. 27, 1924	"Tomb Hunting, Valley of the Kings" Alberta, Canada
Aug. 13, 1925	"Miss Ethel Hall of Buffalo is home with her father, who is in very poor health." <i>Titusville Herald</i>
Oct. 11, 1928	"King Tut's Tomb" Neewah, Wisc, Kiwanis Club.
Feb. 18, 1930	Traveled around the World 3 times.
Feb. 25, 1930	Preaches North Street Congregational Church "Reflecting the Glory of the Lord"
May 13, 1930	EGYPT complete presentation in the <i>Gleaner</i> Newspaper
Feb. 17, 1931	"My Visit to Palestine" lantern slides at N. St. Congregational, Jamaica
Feb. 19, 1931	"Capture of Jerusalem by British Troops" <i>Gleaner</i>
July 10, 1931	"Holy Land" Duke St. Christian Church (Disciples) Rev. O.G. Penso, minister
Aug. 18, 1931	EGYPT another complete presentation in the <i>Gleaner</i>
Sept. 15, 1931	Preaches Baptist Church
Jan. 21, 1932-Dec. 1932	USA Lecture tour. Preaching at a Baptist Church & leaves Jamaica 1 year.
Mar. 29, 1932	Leaving Jamaica and going to USA. Conducted 224 services in Kingston and
June 1932	county parrishes in last two years. Attends son's wedding in Macminville, OR.
Feb. 17, 1933	15 speaking engagements in USA Inducted as Minister at Brixton Hill Congregational Church

Apr. 25, 1933 Brixton Hill Carnival and Cricket Game at the Manse
 Sept. 14, 1933 Education School Board member
 June 1933-Apr. 20, 1934 2 1/2 mos. to San Francisco & Washington D.C. "gassed in war"
 Lost Veteran disability pay & went to inquire. Returned by ship from
 Port Arthur, TX
Discharged by Congregational Church. Hall's "Gethsemane"
Ordained by 1st Christian Port Arthur, TX
 Apr. 30, 1934 Brixton Hill gives vote of confidence.
 June 11, 1934-Jan. 19, 1935 150 places Lecture Tour USA to schools, colleges,
 & churches
 Aug. 4, 1934 Leg injuries, to San Francisco for an operation. Won't return for several
 months.
 July 16, 1935 Egypt Lecture with Torrington Christian Church
 Sept. 11, 1935 Living Link Missionary with 1st Christian, W. Salem, IL.
 Nov. 1935 Meets Luke Elliott, minister to Los Angeles, CA church-later 1st Pres. of
 JBS
 May 7, 1936 Dedicate Baptismal Pool "fouling rivers"
 May 15, 1936 Hall's Tribute to Allenby. Gleaner
 Mar. 27, 1937 Field Evangelist for the Churches of Christ in Jamaica
 May 14, 1937 Baptisms at Richmond Park
 June 29, 1937 Port Arthur, TX--Lodge 65 100F lecture enlisted in US Army at Dallas,
 TX
 Dec.24, 1937 Allenby in Egypt and the "Curse of Tut" Hampton, IA C of Christ
 June 1, 1938 C. V. Hall returned to the Island of Jamaica last Thursday
 June 2-25, 1938 Luke Elliott of Los Angeles left for Jamaica to visit and to begin Bible
 School
JAMAICA BIBLE SEMINARY
 July 14, 1938 To USA 3 months for medical treatments.
 July 24, 1939 Car accident in US before return to Jamaica, no serious injuries.
 Oct. 7, 1939 On passenger list of cargo ship arriving to Kingston harbour.
 Mar. 15, 1940 Southside Christian Church, Hammond, Ind. begins week revival.
 Oct. 6, 1941 Marries Mrs. Stacey Hasner of White Deer, TX, taught chemistry at
 IA State Univ., Rancher, and will accompany lecture tour and run the
 ranch.
 Oct. 7, 1941 Lecture tour N.Amarillo, TX Kiwanis, "member of Howard Carter Arch
 Expedition"
Feb. 26, 1945 Dies in Kingston, buried at May Pen Cemetery, Kingston aged 64.
 Mar. 30, 1945 Property purchased for Mocho of 3 acres: by "CECIL VINCENT
 EMERICH HALL"
 Jan. 14, 1947 Jamaica Bible Seminary with **8 students in Ewarton** with Richard D.
 Elliott &
 Luke D. Elliott.
